The event lasts for a half day and is ideally suited to smaller groups up to 30 delegates.



After the event the rogues gallery of 'busts' can be taken back to the office and put on display, taken home as a completely unique event memento or as was the case in one event we did - used for archery practice...Hmmm!

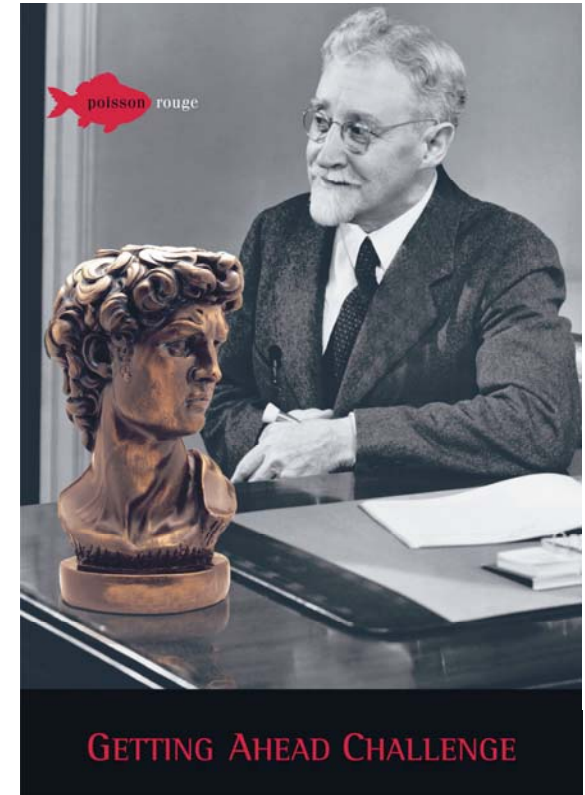


This activity is about doing something so completely different that it pulls teams together.
