

# The Spy Challenge

The Spy Challenge is a high energy team activity for developing team spirit, having fun, being competitive and appealing to the James Bond in all of us.

To start with teams must graduate through 'Spy School' where they will each be taken through some or all of the following:



Observation and Reconnaissance, Code and Cipher Breaking, Problem Solving, Map Reading, International Flag Identification, Industrial and Corporate Espionage, Language Creation, Non Verbal Communication and Ballistics.



Planning, strategy, co-ordination, communication and interdependency all play their part as teams race against the clock to solve riddles, find information and be first to retrieve hidden caches of enemy ballistics.

Then the nature of the game changes as teams must now deploy their collective resources and work together to first build and then fire the ballistic missiles. (The ballistics are real rockets which in some cases can fly to a height of over 1000 feet.)



At the end of the challenge, the team which has amassed the most information, successfully taken the most covert photographs and / or achieved the most key objectives tailored to that specific event will win the prizes.

This event can be run in formats lasting from 3 hours to 2 days. It can be operated anywhere and involves both indoor and outdoor activity.



It requires a min of 1 full day set up for venues and locations not previously used by Poisson Rouge.
